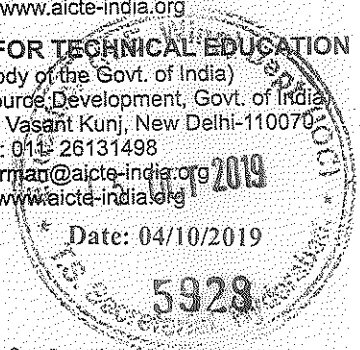

As you are aware that 238 Institutes of State of Telangana were scrutinized for Land and Building Plan approval related documents. The Scrutiny reports were falling under three categories namely Violation of G.O. Ms. No. 111 of Government of Andhra Pradesh/Telangana, BHODAN/URBAN Land Surplus Land and rest others. The conduct of Scrutiny arose due to complaint by Aurora Educational Society, Telangana. In the complaint, it was alleged that 238 institutes are not possessing related land documents issued by Competent Authority, shortage of land, Institutions functioning in catchment area against National Green Tribunal norms, etc.

While these scrutiny reports were under examination, D.O. letters dated 08/04/2018 & dated 09/04/2018 from Hon'ble Chief Minister of Telangana addressed to Hon'ble Minister of HRD requesting two years' extension was received. 116th EC Meeting held on 26/04/2018 which decided to grant the EOA for A/Y 2018-19 subject to condition that all these institutes should submit compliance of deficiencies before applying for EOA for A/Y 2019-20. Accordingly, EOA for AY 2018-19 was issued to all such institutes.

Further, based on your D.O. letter No. 128/TE/A2/2019 dated 13/03/2019 informing the time consuming process for modification and amendments of Master Plan, Building Regulation, etc., one more year time was also granted to these institutes. All these institutes were issued EOA for A/Y 2019-20.

5 Since the 2 years' time as requested by you is over, the land related documents are to be scrutinized essentially before issuing approval to these institutes for AY 2020-21. Based on outcome of the scrutiny report AICTE shall decide on extension of Approval for AY 2020-21 as per Approval Process Hand Book (APH). In this regard, I had requested you vide No AICTE/SCR/Complaint/230+Institute/2018-19 dated 17/06/2019 to look personally in the matter and decide regularization of all related issues before 31 October 2019.

6 In light of the above, I would like to once again request you to decide regularization of all related matters before 31.10.2019.
